

Find your true 'home' in a Soul Connection small group

Contemporary author Melissa McClone wrote, "Life takes you to unexpected places. Love brings you home."

Has there been anything we could say that could better describe our experience of the last two years? Who could have expected the things we've seen? The things we've been through? The storms we've weathered? The places we have found ourselves? I certainly didn't see them coming. However, even in the midst of the uncertainties of life, love continues to bring us home.

As we enter a new school year and new season, I would like for you to consider **Soul Connections** as a way to connect with others, grow in the love of Christ, and find a spiritual home through small group discipleship.

True "home" is to be found where our hearts connect with God and others, and I think a Soul Connection group is the perfect place to find a home to weather the unexpected places life will take you.

These relationship-driven small groups are open to all and will be offered at varying times and days of the week, meeting weekly **September 26 through November 7.** Consisting of about eight to 12 individuals, each Soul Connection Group allows participants to do life together, further connecting with God and one another in transformational community.

Modeled after early Methodist Class Meetings, these revolve around discussion of the scripture passage from the previous week and two primary "check-in" questions that were employed by the founder of Methodism, John Wesley: 1) "How is it with your soul?" 2) "How did you experience God this week?" Utilizing these two questions, Wesley gave people who had experiences of God in worship, the opportunity to dive deeper into their faith and prioritize their daily walk with Christ within the context of small group discipleship.

When you fill out the form, you can choose group preferences most convenient for you, or signify a specific group you would most like to join. As we form the groups, we will do our very best to honor your preferences. **Registration runs through Sunday, September 19.** Hard copies of interest forms can be found in this edition of The Flame, in the Church Office, or at the Soul Connections table set up in the Narthex before and after worship each week. They can be dropped off or mailed to the church. Following the registration period, a minister or Soul Connections host will contact you about your group.

I cannot wait to see the ways that God continues to use this new discipleship opportunity to help us grow in the grace of God together at First United Methodist Church in 2021!




